SURFACE PREPARATION

Sweep and/or blow surface clean removing excess dirt and debris.

APPLICATION

When ready to use, shake bottle, attach hose and you are ready to go! Start at far end of driveway – Turn to ON position and soak troubled areas. You may need to scrub if stain is not rinsing away. After driveway has been power washed change to RINSE setting and rinse driveway. Allow to dry prior to sealing over.

PRECAUTIONS

Wear gloves, eye protection, and cover exposed skin areas. Apply when there is no wind. Temperature should be a minimum of $50 \,^{\circ}$ F and rising. Do not spray plants, animals, or people. keep children and pets away from area and runoff while cleaning. Store and transport container in a safe place, make sure sprayer is tight and secure at all times, and protect from spills inside a bag or box.

CLEAN UP & STORAGE

Do not allow to freeze. Product is non-hazardous.

!!!CAUTION!!!

Emergency & First Aid Procedures:

Eyes: Immediately flush with clean water for 15 minutes while holding eyelids open; consult a physician.

Inhalation: If overcome by mist or vapor, remove from exposure immediately; call a physician. If breathing is stopped or irregular, start resuscitation, administer oxygen.

Skin: Remove any contaminated clothing and wash skin with soap and warm water. Vegetable or mineral oil can remove dry material.

Ingestion: DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING even though vomiting may occur. If vomiting occurs, keep head below hips to prevent aspiration of liquid into the lungs. Get immediate medical attention.
